WASHINGTON, Jan. 11.—Secretary Morton will leave here on Saturday for Chicago, prepared to appear as a witness before the Interstate Commerce commission in its investigation of the Colorado Fuel and Iron company's violation of law. Mr. Morton, formerly vice-president of the Santos Fe, and will confer with the president of the company, Mr. Rindler, before reaching a decision as to when he will appear before the commission.

SAN FRANCISCO, Jan. 11.—The rate war between the steam schooners and the Harri-mann, Columbia and George W. Elder, has been averted for a time. The steam schooner managers' association has been meeting and concluded to find an amicable solution to the problem without resorting to rate-cutting, by conference with the rival interests.

**No Danger in Competition.**

BERLIN, Jan. 11.—Finance Minister Von Rheinbaben, in introducing the budget in the Prussian Diet, referred to German-American trade relations. He said it was wholly erroneous that Germany could gain anything through a decline in the economic prosperity of the United States. The danger of American competition, which had never been estimated very high, had greatly receded since the growing improvement of business in the United States had broadened the consumptive demand there. The budget balances at \$27,255,550.
