HIGH JUMP RECORD ON ROLLER SKATES

Davidson Easily Accomplishes Feat Which Is Regarded as Extremely Difficult.

Tribune Special Sporting Service. NEW YORK, July 7.—John Davidson, cyclist and skater, created a new world's record for running high jump on roller skates at Madison Square Garden rink this week. Davidson cleared the bar at 3 feet 10 inches with little apparent effort. His jump was about 3 inches better than the record, as he was that height when he went over. His first jump was 2 feet 6 inches, when the bar was raised 2 inches. He experienced no difficulty in getting over this. Another 2 inches was added for the third attempt, which he cleared easily.

How Record Was Broken.

To accomplish his record-breaking feat Davidson started about 25 yards from the standards. He increased his speed at every stride. He gradually crouched, and when at the proper distance for the jump he suddenly, by an immense effort, lifted his body from the floor. The impetus he had gathered from his great speed carried him clear over the tape and landed him on the other side on a perfect balance. He traveled half the distance around the rink before he could stop himself.

Most Difficult Athletic Feat.

High jumping on roller skates is one of the most difficult of athletic feats. The athlete is not able to secure any purchase from the floor to aid him in the jump, while the disadvantage is multiplied by the fact that extraordinary speed is required to accomplish it. Should the skater fail in securing a proper footing after the jump, it is declared a foul, and this fact makes it one of the fairest as well as most difficult tasks in athletic sports.

Says Efforts to Stop Sunday Play Are Productive of Greater Evil.



He recently wrote a characteristic article on what he calls, "The Puritan Peril." "There are a good many of us," he says, "who are, or at any rate who believe ourselves to be, sound enough democrats at heart, but who, nevertheless, feel discomforting qualms when we contemplate some of the later and less obvious developments of democracy. "What is called the settled temperance policy of the London County Council has already cost the ratepayers of London \$1,650,000, with the result, not of reducing drunkenness, but of adding vastly to the profits of the public-houses near those whose licenses have

been extinguished. That is one of the notes of Puritanism; it never succeeds in doing even the thing it desires to do. It tries to make England dull; all it achieves is to make England dull. CHRISTIE ENTERS HIS AUTO.

Will Drive Car in American Elimination Trials for Vanderbilt Cup. Tribune Special Sporting Service. NEW YORK, July 7.—Walter Christie has entered his 115 horse-power Christie car for the American elimination trials for the Vanderbilt cup race, and will drive it himself. It was entered through the Automobile club of America. The entry will attract attention, as the machine established a record for American courses—except the Ormond-Daytona beach course, when it went a mile in 35

seconds on the Atlantic City sand course a few months ago. Mr. Christie had a car entered in the name of James Breeze in the elimination trials last year, but it failed to qualify. At a meeting held shortly after the trials by the racing board of the American Automobile association, three of the five cars that qualified were thrown out,

and the Christie car was one of those substituted. As in the elimination trials the machine made a poor showing in the big races, and was finally put out of commission by running into the Fiat car driven by Lancia, who had a lead of twenty minutes at the time. The accident prevented the Italian driver from

getting better than fourth place in the race. Christie is the designer of the car, and has made several changes on the machine since last year. At the recent open-air automobile show at Empire City track he drove the car a mile in 33 seconds, equalling the record for a circular track made by "Barney" Oldfield.
