Factor Which Characterized the Trading of Thursday is Not Long Maintained.

HIGH CURRENCY PREMIUM UNFAVORABLE FACTOR

Bankers Say Funds Are Too Much Scattered Among Small Concerns.

NEW YORK, Dec. 6.—Today's stock market was characterized by the animation of the market yesterday, but was even more so today.

NEW YORK, Dec. 6.—The London tin market was higher today, with spot quoted at \$135 and futures at \$136.

Copper was higher in London, with spot advancing to 261 1/2, and futures to 262 1/2.

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FINE MALAGA GRAPES TO TENT PURCHASERS

Luscious Fruit Is Added to Week-End Display on Market Row.

Malaga grapes, straight from sunny Spain, at 25 cents the pound, were placed on market row Friday morning for the first time in the memory of the shoppers.

Tomatoes (20 cents a pound) from California were also placed on the stands today.

Fish was one of Friday's features. A big supply of northern shrimps, 25 cents a quart, tempted palates and curiosities of the buyers.

A decrease in the price of chickens is scheduled for Saturday. Where these fowl have formerly brought \$2.50 a dozen, thereabout, certain stores will make a price of 15 cents.

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UPWARD TENDENCY IN THE WHEAT MARKET

Decrease of Supply in Northwest and Firmness of Stocks Help Bulls.

CHICAGO, Dec. 6.—Decreased stocks of wheat in the Northwest and the firmness of the stock market are the main factors influencing today on the local wheat market.

The wheat market was inclined to be weak at the start, owing to advices from Argentina to the effect that harvesting was progressing favorably and that the crop is in good condition.

The market developed considerable firmness toward the middle of the day because of reports from the Northwest and Winnipeg, due to depleted stocks of wheat at those centers.
