Although the census enumerators will positively cease their work Thursday night, persons who have not been enumerated will be given a reasonable length of time to get their names and addresses to the census supervisor, Hugh A. McMillin, supervisor of census, said Tuesday that in his opinion the only persons whose names do not appear on the population schedules are those who have willfully evaded the enumerators and purposely kept their names from the office.

Prevention, Not Cures, Most Required in Tuberculosis

WASHINGTON, May 3.—Whether tuberculosis is caused by milk or meat infected from bovine sources, and what may be the best employment for sufferers from tuberculosis, were the chief subjects discussed today at the session of the National Association for the Study and Prevention of Tuberculosis.

Discussion on the former topic was started by Dr. William H. Park of New York, and on the latter by Dr. A. M. Forster of Louisville, Ky. Dr. Park held that pulmonary tuberculosis among adults was not the result of impure milk or foods.

Dr. S. Adolphus Knopf of New York attacked the Nebraska law which requires indigent consumptives to submit to the serum treatment, and also the action of the Oklahoma state board of medical examiners which forbids any physician to practice in the state if he is or has been afflicted with tuberculosis.

Dr. L. F. Barker of Johns Hopkins university at Baltimore presided as chairman of the clinical section, and Dr. Theobald Smith of Boston presided at the pathological section.

Dr. Park asserted that but 2 1/2 per cent of all tuberculosis in New York City comes from infected milk, butter or meat from bovine sources. Moreover, said Dr. Park, this small percentage is found mainly in children. In other words, pulmonary tuberculosis among adults is contracted solely from human beings and is not the result of impure milk or foods.

Dr. Park supported throughout his paper the contention advanced by Dr. Robert Koch of Berlin, the discoverer of the tuberculosis germ, when he stood practically alone in declaring that cattle did not transmit pulmonary tuberculosis to human beings.

The significance of these conclusions, it was pointed out, will be to direct all the energy of the campaign against tuberculosis to combating the spread of this disease among human beings by preventing spitting, bad housing, over-
