

LARGE NUMBER TOURISTS COME

First Results of Park and Pacific Rates Throughout the East.

SALT LAKE GATEWAY FOR WESTERN TRAVEL

Estimated That 1500 Stopped Over in This City on Wednesday.

That Salt Lake is the gateway to the Pacific was demonstrated Wednesday. It was the first showing of results of Pacific and Yellowstone round-trip rates in the east, and the number of tourists in town was the largest that has been noted on any one day this year.

HAWLEY IS RECOGNIZED BY THE UNION PACIFIC

NEW YORK, June 15.—President Lovett of the Union and Southern Pacific railroads today officially confirmed the reports of a traffic agreement between the Southern Pacific and the St. Louis & San Francisco railroad stating that the agreement went into effect today and would continue for ten years.

The following statement was issued by President Lovett: "The north and south lines of the Southern Pacific system have not crossed the northern border of Texas."

Formerly they received considerable business from the Missouri, Kansas & Texas and had its own lines to the Gulf and the latter, with the Colorado & Southern, about three years ago, jointly constructed a line to the Gulf and Fort Worth.

"The present agreement provides that the Southern Pacific and the Frisco shall work preferentially for traffic between the south and central Texas, St. Louis, Kansas City, Oklahoma and other points north. It is a traffic agreement solely, neither party having any running rights on the lines of the other and no financial commitments of any character are involved."


A little freight clerk arriving at the home of Fred Barnes of the Short Line has caused congratulations to that young railroader and best wishes to his wife.

VERDICT IS AGAIN IN FAVOR OF MORGAN

Judge Armstrong on Wednesday rendered judgment in favor of defendant in the case of Frederick A. Earls against James Morgan. Earls sued to recover \$236.08 which he alleged he advanced to purchase stock in the Summit Mining company for Morgan and which Morgan failed to repay. Morgan contended that the district court had no jurisdiction in the case for the reason that the cause of action arose in Juab county and he resides in that county. He also claimed that F. G. Luke filed suit against him in Eureka in 1903 on the same cause of judgment was rendered in favor of Morgan and that that action is a bar to this one. Judge Armstrong so held and again rendered judgment in favor of Morgan.

NEW CONTRIVANCE AT THE WEATHER BUREAU

A. H. Thiessen, section director of the United States weather bureau, has arranged for a thermometer to be used in connection with the thermometers on the top of the building. 
