

**HISTORIC BIBLE USED BY CHIEF JUSTICE**

Head of Supreme Court Signs His Oath of Office on Bench.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 19.—In the presence of a distinguished gathering in the courtroom, Edward Douglas White today elevated from associate justice to the supreme court of the United States to the chief justiceship.

The climax of the ceremonies occurred when Chief Justice Harlan, as senior member of the court, administered the oath. It was subscribed to on the bench itself instead of at the clerk's desk, as is ordinarily the case.

Chief Justice White, while taking the oath, held in his hand a Bible which has been used by nearly every chief justice since the court was organized in 1789. The Bible is a copy of the King James version of the Bible, and is one of the most valuable possessions of the court.

ST. PAUL, Minn., Dec. 19.—A bill will be presented to the coming legislature asking for an appropriation of \$1000 a year to further the education of Vera Madsen, 16 years old, who has been unable to speak, hear or see since her birth. Miss Madsen has been in the state school for the blind at Faribault only three years, yet she writes on the typewriter with skill, has a vocabulary of 3000 words, and recently wrote an essay of 5000 words. She makes her own clothes, threading her own needles, and is skilled in fancy work.

**SCARED OUT OF HIS WITS BY PASSENGER TRAIN**

SHERIDAN, Wyo., Dec. 19.—Losing his presence of mind while standing on a rail-road bridge spanning the Tongue river, Jack Wawrzas, a Polish miner, was so frightened yesterday at seeing a passenger train approaching that he ran head-long into the train. He was hurled fifteen feet into the air and fell dead along the track. He had cleared the bridge and could easily have jumped to either side of the embankment to safety.

**BORAH'S BILL ALLOWING ENTRIES PASSES SENATE**

WASHINGTON, Dec. 19.—The senate today passed Senator Borah's bill permitting entry upon lands under irrigation projects which have been relinquished by the original locators, without regard to the provision in the act of the last session prohibiting entries until after irrigation charges are paid. The new measure applies only to old projects.
