Lieblers' Loss \$100,000 as Result of Composer's Refusal to Produce "Ysobel" in This Country.

NEW YORK, Jan. 12.—The luck clings to all the American ventures of the great composer, Pietro Mascagni.

The composer, Pietro Mascagni, when he first toured America he was driven distracted by strange injunction suits, attachments, court summonses, mandamus and other torturing inventions of the common and statute law.

From assertions from both Tyler and Mascagni, each is now willing to have the matter settled in the courts, both claiming to have suffered damages.

Meawhile, Liebler & Co., after having been put to the expense of paying twenty-two orchestra players \$7.50 a day since they left Europe in November, will now be compelled to add to the sum paid for their transportation to this country a similar amount, including salaries, to send them home.

Mascagni insisted that these musicians be engaged.

George C. Taylor of Canada, who has just returned from Canada, asserts the Italian composer's methods are responsible for the situation which deprives the American public of a great undertaking and has entailed a loss to the backers of the enterprise aggregating, it is said, \$100,000.

Mascagni, on the other hand, charges his American representatives with "bluffing," and still expresses his willingness to carry out what he says is his part of the contract.

TRIFFEY EXPLAINS PRESIDENT PLEADS FOR LONGWORTH BILL AND FOR PERMANENCY OF BOARD.

Believes in Congress Revising the Schedules Business of Commission, He Says, Should Be Ascertain-ing the Facts.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 12.—Significant progress was made today in the movement for the creation of a permanent tariff commission.

Not only did President Taft, in an address at the banquet of the National Tariff Commission association, openly endorse the Longworth bill, characterizing it as a "conciliatory measure, embodying all the important features that are necessary to make the commission effective," but early today he summoned the Republican members of the ways and means committee to the White House and urged them to harmonize their differences.

The president renewed his plea for harmony in his address tonight, declaring that what he was most anxious to avoid was the failure of tariff commission legislation at the present session because of any differences as to details.

He declared that he would not mention "the bill that bears the name of the Ohio congressman," except that it seemed to him to "constitute a very well drawn compromise upon all the difficult points that have divided the two supporters of various measures."

Longworth Bill Features.

The Longworth bill, referred to by the president, according to its author, is an important one, and it is his hope that the Longworth and the Goodie bills of the house and of the La Follette and the Beveridge bills of the senate.

The National Tariff Commission association early today endorsed the Longworth bill in a resolution sent to congress, demanding immediate tariff commission legislation, and that the body should be largely of the resolution that President Taft spoke tonight.

Denies Any Monopoly.

His extended remarks about the reorganization of the Standard Oil company of New Jersey in 1899, which is the thing which the decree of the lower court would undo, was summarized by Justice Hughes.

"The net result," suggested Justice Hughes, "is that the Standard Oil company of New Jersey after 1899 stood in the place of the trustees and those who held the certificates issued by the trustees thereafter held the stock of the Standard Oil company of New Jersey."

"Precisely," said Mr. Milburn, "it is quite simple when you understand it. You see, there was the same body of common owners of the property both before and after 1899."

At this point he referred to the argument of the Standard upon which it is pinning its faith in the present controversy, that the new arrangements of 1899 did not suppress competition in any way, because the properties before 1899 were not competing, they being owned by the same persons.
