

EUROPE SELLS STOCK AND PRICES GO LOWER

Undertone of the Market However, Is Strong; Wall Street Does Not Expect Currency Legislation.

By International News Service. NEW YORK, July 17.—The rising tendencies in Wednesday's market were checked at the opening today by heavy selling for foreign account. The selling did not come through the regular arbitrage channel. Canadian Pacific, Union Pacific Steel and California Petroleum were conspicuous on the list of the shares marketed.

Undertone Steady.

The undertone of the market could not be called weak. Steel held steady all day and aside from the 1 per cent drop in the Pacific, losses were in the general list mostly fractional. It was reported that Europe is buying copper metal on a larger scale than at any time for many weeks, but local manufacturers have failed to come into the market.

WHEAT SHARE LOWER CHICAGO MARKET

Huge Receipts at Primary Points Offsets the Bullish Sentiment.

CHICAGO, July 17.—Huge receipts at primary points today acted as an offset for bullish sentiment in the wheat pit. Accordingly, the market closed steady at a shade to be under last night. Corn finished with a gain of 1-16c to 2-16c, outside up 1/8c, and provisions showing an advance of 1/8c to 3/8c.

Money Situation Abroad.

No fresh offers of foreign money were made in this market, but the reported improvement was justified by the showings in the weekly statements of the great European banks. The Bank of England gained \$4,000,000 during the week, and now has a ratio of reserve to liability of 53.4, a more favorable showing than had been made at this time for many years.
