OPERATION URGED SECRETARY LANE

Member Addresses Meeting of National Conservation Congress.

EXPERTS ON HAND Present From All of the United States and Canada.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 17.--Conservationists from all sections of the country and a delegation from the United States and Canada.

Sectional meetings were held which preliminary features of the conservation policy were discussed.

Secretary declared that the greatest obstacle in the preparation of a conservation policy was the narrowness of those who believed in the conservation of government and those who believed in the state's rights.

Commercial Planting. "Successful commercial planting," the report concluded, "depends upon a good future market, lands of low value upon which to plant a choice of species suited to the needs of the market and to the conditions, local and regional, relative freedom from sources of damage, a low initial cost of planting and a return on the money invested equal at least to a fair return of interest. The long-time nature of the investment makes planting more feasible for the federal, state and local governments or long-lived corporations than that of individual or smaller companies."

Other addresses were made before the association of commerce by Dr. C. R. Van Hise, president of the University of Wisconsin; Dr. George Otis Smith, director of the geological survey; H. J. Waters, president of the Kansas State Agricultural college; C. F. Marbut, United States bureau of soils, and C. B. Waldron of the department of agriculture and forestry of North Dakota Agricultural college.

AMENDED PETITION FILED IN THAW CASE

Hearing Will Be Given in the Federal Court at Concord, N. H., Today.

CONCORD, N. H., Nov. 17.--The amended petition for a writ of habeas corpus, which acts as a stay in the removal of Harry K. Thaw from New Hampshire to New York, was filed by Thaw's attorneys in the United States district court here today. The amendments to the original petition were necessitated by the indictment in New York county, charging conspiracy to escape from the Matteawan asylum.

A hearing on the amended petition of Thaw and also on the petition of the state of New York for the dismissal of the habeas corpus proceedings will be given in the federal court here tomorrow.

Thaw asks that the writ issue on the ground that he is a citizen of Pennsylvania; that his commitment to the Matteawan asylum was illegal; that the section of the New York criminal code under which he was committed conflicts with the fourteenth amendment, and that the petition for his extradition do not charge a crime.

The petition further says that "the proceedings on the part of the special deputy attorney general of the state of New York establish bad faith and are convincing evidence of a purpose to obtain possession of Thaw not for trial on the conspiracy indictment, but for re-confinement in Matteawan."

RUSSIAN PREMIER ON VISIT TO GERMANY

BERLIN, Nov. 17.--The Russian premier and his suite arrived here today and conferred for some time with the German imperial chancellor, Dr. von Bethmann-Hollweg.

The reason for the visit is generally assumed to be the financial side of the railroad construction and development of Turkey. Russian finances and the general European political situation were also probably touched on.

The Russian statesman was accompanied by Leonide Federovitch Davidoff, his principal subordinate in the Russian ministry of finance, and by Nikolayoff, the guest of Emperor William at luncheon on Wednesday, and will dine with the imperial chancellor tomorrow. He leaves on Thursday.

MORE ACCIDENTS IN WISCONSIN WOODS

ASHLAND, Wis., Nov. 17.--Henry L. Gardner, manager of the Rice Lake Excelsior company, died today as the result of being shot through the body by an unidentified hunter on Thursday.

COUDERAY, Wis., Nov. 17.--A man by the name of Demars, said to reside near Park Falls, was found dead today in the woods three miles north of Draper, in this county. He had been hunting, and is believed to have been killed by the accidental discharge of his own gun.

POLICE LOOKING FOR SUFFRAGIST LEADER

WASHINGTON, Nov. 17.--Miss Lucy Burns, who led a firing squad of suffragists and covered the sidewalks in front of the White house with "Votes for Women" last week, was being sought by the police today on a warrant charging her with violation of a city ordinance which forbids placing signs on pavements. Miss Burns is vice chairman of the congressional union of the National Woman Suffrage association.
