

RAPID WORK DONE ON BIG TUNNEL

Snake Creek Avenue Advanced 298 Feet in Month of March.

The big Snake Creek tunnel, designed to unwater a large area of the southwestern part of the great mineralized region about Park City, made an advance of 298 feet in 28 1/2 working days of two shifts each in the month of March.

The formation being penetrated at this time is about the same as for some time past, being favorable to rapid work, while the flow of water is not excessive.

This great piece of work was inaugurated and is being carried out by the Snake Creek Mining & Tunnel company, composed chiefly of the Daly-Judge and Knight interests.

The tunnel is a large one, being 6 1/2 by 9 feet and is intended to accommodate a double track road and to be used for transportation as well as drainage.

Under one track it carries a waterway 5 1/2 by 1 feet which is sufficient to carry a flow of 15,000 gallons a minute.

The tunnel is so located that a railroad could be built right up to it. The tunnel is big enough and its depth is sufficient to eventually drain the upper part of the Alta district if it is ever seen fit to extend it there.

The length of the tunnel as now planned is 14,350 feet. It was started three years ago and is now something over half completed.

PINE DOME COMPANY GETS BIG OIL WELL

The Pine Dome Oil company, owned by a number of prominent Salt Lake people, drilled in its first well in the Salt Creek field, forty-five miles north of Casper, Wyo., recently, and pumping proves its initial capacity to be 200 barrels a day.

The company has contracted for the drilling of four more wells. The proven field is about eight miles long and four miles wide and the Pine Dome company's territory lies at the northwest corner of this area.

The production of the Salt Creek field is much greater than that of any of the other oil areas of Wyoming, having been something like 4,000,000 barrels in 1913, while it is predicted the 1914 production will reach 4,500,000 barrels.

Two pipe lines convey the oil to Casper where three refineries are located, a new one costing \$1,200,000 having just been completed by the Standard Oil company.

BIG LEAD STRIKE AT BAYHORSE, IDAHO

News is received in Challis of a big lead strike made near Bayhorse last week by Fabio Pedrini, says the Challis Messenger. It is a new discovery and it was struck on the surface by prospecting a big iron ledge.

The discovery is a short distance from what is known as Bayhorse High Grade. A six-foot ledge of lead ore was uncovered and it has not yet been developed sufficiently to determine its value, but should the old camp renew something against this kind of ore would be valuable for financing purposes.

PARK CITY MINE DID 1100 FEET OF IT IN MARCH

General Manager George W. Lam-bourne, just returned from Park City, announces that in the month of March 1100 feet of development work was done in Daly-Judge territory.

The ore bodies are responding nicely and the tonnage is keeping up well, that handled at the mill in March being the heaviest for a number of months. The tonnage handled at the mill varies from time to time, depending in part upon whether the development work is being prosecuted in ore or in waste.

The company has very extensive underground workings and its ores come from all parts of the property. The output is now coming from workings extending from above the 500 level to as deep as the 1500 station. It is taken out from within a short distance of the shaft to as far as 2500 feet west of the shaft.

Each month the development work is carried into new territory, and after these years of big development operations the company still has a large area of ground that has not been touched which will require years of work to get opened up.
