INSURANCE HEAD TO BE TRIED

Walter R. Gillette Must Appear on Perjury and Forgery Charge.

New York, Oct. 1.—District Attorney Jerome has decided to put Walter R. Gillette, who was vice president of the Mutual Life Insurance Company, on trial on October 14. Gillette was indicted for perjury and forgery. The trial will be before Justice Dowling, in the criminal branch.

WASHINGTON TRAIN ARRIVES.

The special train bearing the Bishop of London and other dignitaries of the church who have been attending the convention of the Brotherhood of St. Andrew in Washington, and bringing 200 bishop and lay delegates to the convention, arrived in the city this afternoon. Two stoves were made after leaving Washington—the first at Alexandria, where the Episcopal Seminary and grounds were pointed out, and the second at Fredericksburg. At the various battle fields along the route and at the house in which Gen. Stonewall Jackson died, the train slowed down, the interesting points being shown to the occupants of the cars. A crowd of several thousand people met the train at the station.

PARK FOR ROSSLYN PLANNED

Alexandria County Will Ask War Department to Help.

Scheme Is to Beautify Government Reservation at South End of the Aqueduct Bridge.

A plan to turn the government reservation at the Virginia end of the Aqueduct Bridge into a park that would make a suitable approach to the Arlington National Cemetery, was formulated at a meeting of the board of trade of Alexandria County, held at Rosslyn yesterday afternoon.

QUESTIONS TO BE CONSIDERED.

Commissioners were named at Boston, charged with reporting at Richmond on suffragan bishops, upon the condition and uplifting of the colored man, upon civil legislation in the matter of marriage and divorce, and upon Christian education. Laid over for Richmond at the Boston convention were courts of appeal, provinces, permissive use of the revised version, and a canon embodying the Huntington amendment. The colored man, his situation and improvement, will be given careful consideration, and canon on marriage and divorce, which was adopted by the Boston convention as a compromise measure after a disagreement between the bishops and the deputies will be further considered.
