Trainman Killed by Robbers. Philip P. Kramer's head had been crushed by a heavy blow, and he had apparently been killed while asleep. Robbery is supposed to have been the motive for the crime, as several hundred dollars, which were known to have been in Kramer's room, were found to be missing.

AMERICAN SOLDIERS HONORED. Performed Deeds of Valor in Philippine Skirmishes. Distinguished Themselves While Under Fire—Lieut. Cecil Wins Medal of Honor. The fight between American troops and a band of hostile Moros at Bud Dajo, island of Jolo, March 7 and 8, 1905, enabled many officers and enlisted men of the Philippine Division to distinguish themselves for bravery and gallant conduct.

ROOSEVELT'S SWORD FALLS. Maj. Crabb's First Officer Affected by Horseback Test. The first retirement due to the President's recent horseback riding order was announced at the War Department yesterday. The victim is Maj. Joseph T. Crabb, quartermaster's department, who was unable to take the prescribed ride because of injuries which prevented him from taking part in the exercise. Maj. Crabb's seven years ago sustained an injury to his leg while horseback riding at West Point, where he was an instructor, but he has been able, however, to properly discharge his duties. Recently he has had charge of the work of constructing the Walter Reed Hospital in this city.
