

FLORIDA TRACKS BAD

Trainers Springing Yarns that Condemn Promoters.

ALL GRAFT CLEAR THROUGH

Owner Calls Treatment of Honest Horsemen in Florida Blot Upon Racing Which Cannot Be Erased. Says It's All the Property of Certain Exclusive Rings.

New York, March 18.—Methods of Florida race track promoters were discussed by some of the trainers at Gravesend to-day and several turfmen, who have just arrived here with their horses told interesting yarns.

"Not satisfied with collecting a big revenue from bookmakers in addition to gate receipts paid by the public, these promoters have wrung money out of jockeys and trainers by fining them heavily for trivial offenses and even have compelled them to pay exorbitant rates for eating their meals at the race track kitchen.

Graft at Betting Game. "They've also been in with another part of the game—the betting, and they've got the money, too. It's a cinch to own a race track, control bookmakers, horses, and jockeys, and then put down the checks in the right spot, eh? It's also luck when the starter lets an educated horse off running while the others are as good as left at the barriers. No wonder bookmakers and others not in the play are taking the pledge never to go to the land of orange groves again. Why the rank and file are all broke and will be lucky to get out of Florida with the price of a meat ticket.

Worst Conditions Ever Known. "Such conditions never prevailed at Gettysburg, Gloucester, Iron Hill, and other sure thing tracks, yet there is nobody but the lawmakers and prosecuting authorities in Florida who can put a stop to them. It is easy to see now why these race track dictators put into effect a rule prohibiting criticism of the methods in vogue and why even outspoken women have been ruled off for saying too much. The Jockey Club, in the interests of racing, should at least make an investigation of these proceedings if only to fix the blame and bar the guilty ones from the New York tracks. The treatment of honest horsemen in Florida is a blot upon racing which can never be erased."
