COMMISSIONERS' NOTICE. COMMISSIONERS OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, Washington, D. C., July 5, 1910.—Ordered: That Article VII of the Police Regulations of the District of Columbia is hereby amended by designating the present Section 3 as Section 4, and by adding immediately after Section 7 of said Article, a new Section as follows: Section 8. No person shall bring into the District of Columbia from any other State, Territory or jurisdiction, on foot, on horse, on mule, on pack, on sled, on sledge, on cart, on wagon, or on any other
