

RACE NEARLY OVER

Olympia League Winner Is Still in Doubt.

FIGHT BETWEEN TWO TEAMS

St. Stephen's and Olives Will Meet Twice Before Final Fall of Current—Fast Base Runners in Circuit. All-star Team Has Average Clouting Ability of .445.

OLYMPIA LEAGUE TEAM.

ALL-STAR TEAM. Pitchers—Sullivan, Olives; McDonough, St. Stephen's. Catcher—Hillery, Olives. First base—Myers, Olives. Second base—Kearney, Spartan.

The Olympia League schedule is about to close, and yet the pennant winner has not been decided. The race, however, has narrowed down to two teams, the Olive, and St. Stephen's. These clubs meet twice this month and the winner of the series will probably be the champion of the league.

The league has on its roster many good ball players, hard hitters, and fast fielders. All, however, have been handicapped in their playing by the bad field. Extensive improvements have been planned for next year, and if they are carried out, the league should be one of the fastest class B circuits in the city.

Good twirlers have been very scarce, there being probably but half a dozen first-class twirlers. Sullivan, of the Olives, is easily best, while McDonough, of St. Stephen's, is second choice. Kidwell, of the Olives, is another good pitcher. Sullivan is also one of the best batters and baserunners in the league, and at present has a batting average of .473.

Hillery undoubtedly deserves the back-stopping position on his team. A good receiver, with an excellent arm, a clean head, and full of pep, Hillery ranks as premier catcher of the league. He also possesses a batting average of .315, and is a dangerous man on the bases; his favorite stunt being that of stealing home. Chappie, of Tennytown, and Noone, of St. Stephen's, are also good catchers, but lack the steadiness and ginger of Hillery.

Myers, of the Olives, stands head and shoulders over the nearest rival for first-base honors. With a long reach, good footwork, a fine arm, and a batting record of .500, the Western High star easily gets the first-base job. Musgrave of Tennytown, and Burlesque, of Tanglewood, are also good first sackers but can not hit with the Olive man.

Kearney, of Spartan, is entitled to second base. The Southwest boy is the leader in batting, with the remarkable average of .550. He ranks as one of the leading run-getters and baserunners in the league, and is a good fielder. Jones, of Tennytown, is a better fielder, as is Mahony, of St. Stephen's, but neither is a hitter like the Spartan infielder.

Schombert a Steady Fielder. Third base goes to Schombert, of St. Stephen's. An excellent and steady fielder, with a clear head and sure arm, the Saint's third-sacker has the right of way. He is the leading rungetter of the league, one of the topnotchers in base stealing, and a hard hitter, with an average of .480.

Howard, of the Olives, is an excellent fielder, but does not wield the wagon tongue as well as he fields. Shortstop is a hard position to select, there being many good shortfielders in the league. Evans, of St. Stephen's, is given first choice. He is a sure fielder, with a strong arm, fast on his feet, and a hard hitter. He has a batting average of .378, and is one of the longest hitters in the circuit.

Left field goes to Eckendorf, of the Olives. He is a hard hitter, fast on the bases, a good ground coverer with a good whip. Eckendorf is first selection for the left out-warden. Daly, of St. Stephen's, is also one of the leading leftfielders, but he is not so good a fielder as is Eckendorf, and his batting average of .377 does not rank as high as the Olive man's mark.

Center field has been given to Rosenbush, of Tanglewood. Rosenbush is one of the hardest hitters in the league, with an average of .477. He is a sure catch, a good ground coverer and has one of the best arms in the league. He is fast on the bases, and one of the leading base-stealers.

Right field is one of the hardest positions to select, on account of every team having nearly six right fielders. L. Freeman, of Tennytown, is judged the best, mostly on account of his hitting. While not a sensational fielder, the suburbanite is a good ground coverer and a reliable man. He is the leading slugger of the league, and has an average of .500.

The above team has been selected impartially by the scorer, who has seen every game of the season. Several players of unquestionable ability have been passed over, for no other reason than that they have given the best part of their time to other leagues about town, and have not been deemed as representatives of the Georgetown League.

TRIMS TWO RECORDS.

The Harvester Wins the 2:06 Trot at North Randall.

Cleveland, Aug. 13.—The Harvester broke two world's records and equalled another in winning the 2:06 trot in the final day of the North Randall Grand Circuit meeting.

Jogging the last eighth in both heats, The Harvester won in 2:04 and 2:03. The last mile equals Cresceus' trotting stallion record.

The two heats are the fastest ever trotted by any stallion, while the heat in 2:03 is the five-year-old stallion record, put by The Harvester himself at 2:04. The summaries:

NOVELTY IS WINNER

Fast Colt Takes Lead and Is Never Headed.

DALMATIAN TAKES TRAVERSE

Officers' Army Service Cup in Which Thoroughbreds Are Hidden by Regular Officers Is Big Event—Lieut. W. J. Scott Has Narrow Escape from Serious Injury—Other Results.

Saratoga, Aug. 13.—S. C. Hildreth scored a double triumph here this afternoon when Novelty and Dalmatian won the rich Saratoga Special and the Traverse Stakes, respectively, in the presence of more than 10,000 enthusiastic spectators. The success of Novelty, a Keene bred colt, was a stunning surprise, as his price, 12 to 1, indicated.

When the barrier went up Shilling rushed Novelty to the front. He was never headed, and drew away gradually in the stretch to win by a length and a half. Iron Mask got the place.

The officers' Army Service Cup, in which thoroughbreds in the army were ridden by regular officers, was a brilliant event. The distance was one mile, and Maj. William M. Roberts brought his mare Sequence home in triumph. She led all the way, and Maj. Roberts rode her out to the wire to win by two lengths. Matabon, with Lieut. Rockwell up, was second, and Colored Lady third. Maj. Roberts received a gold cup.

Lieut. W. J. Scott had a narrow escape from serious injury while riding his own filly, May Lee. On the far turn his mount was caught in a jam and thrown so that Scott received a very nasty fall. He never got up after the fall, and when taken to the jockey's room was in an unconscious condition, and remained in that state for a considerable time before he came to. Then an examination was made and it was found that no bones were broken, but as he was badly shaken up he was sent to the hospital.
