Virginia's Place Among the States. Virginia's rank among the States as an agricultural producer gives her the Department of Agriculture, for 1910, as third in tobacco raising; sixth for buckwheat; fifteenth for white potatoes; sixteenth for rye; seventeenth for winter wheat; twenty-first for corn; twenty-eighth for barley; twenty-ninth for oats, and thirty-third for hay.

CREAM, MILK, AND TYPHOID. Many epidemics of typhoid have been traced to raw milk (Kober).

It has been found that among patients of dairies supplying properly pasteurized milk and cream there occur but very few cases of typhoid (Rossmann).

Properly pasteurizing means heating to 140 degree Fahrenheit for twenty minutes. Home pasteurizing is just as efficient. Commercial pasteurizing is unreliable.

HOME PASTEURIZE IT by bringing it to near boiling, then cool and keep cold and covered until used. Society for Prevention of Sickness E. BERLINER, secretary.
