GARMENT WORKERS' STRIKE SETTLED

Chicago Manufacturers Are Ready to Make Agreement.

Chicago, Jan. 14.—The strike of the garment workers of Chicago, which has been drawn out for many weeks, and which was participated in by nearly 35,000 workers, was practically settled today, when an agreement was signed with Hart Schaffner & Marx, the largest of the clothing manufacturers, which will result in 10,000 employees returning to work within the next ten days.
