BUILDING NEWS AND GOSSIP

BUSINESS PROPERTY SOLD.



The Home Life Building, at Fifteenth and G streets northwest, which has been purchased by the Citizens' Savings Bank for \$330,000.

Mark W. Moore is having plans prepared by W. E. Pinger, architect, for a four-story brick and stone apartment house at 1205 North Capitol street.

Cahill & Dunningan are planning the erection of a two-story brick residence at 1807 Kilbourne street northwest, after plans by N. E. Grimm, architect. The house, which will have an exterior measurement of 21 by 42 feet, will cost about \$2,500.

The week ended yesterday probably was unsatisfactory, as far as projected building operations in the District of Columbia are concerned, as has been experienced in months. 


A BUNGALOW FOR \$2,805.



This beautiful one-and-a-half story bungalow makes a cozy, comfortable, all-year-round cottage. It contains all the features that make a thoroughly satisfactory home. The front porch is of a good size, but not too large to affect the beauty of the house. The large open fireplace with a seat at each side presents a very pleasing view on entering, and affords a fine chance for interior decoration. The dining-room, kitchen, and pantry are well arranged, well lighted, and ventilated. The bedrooms are directly connected, and yet isolated from the rest of the house sufficiently to keep the living room and sleeping apartments separate, with a bath conveniently located. There are two extra bedrooms on the second floor, but they are not shown here.

The finish throughout is North Carolina pine flooring, chestnut finish; outside millwork, white pine. Ceiling heights are: First floor, 9 feet; second floor, 8 feet 6 inches, and cellar, 7 feet.
