A Sure Flea Killer. A sure way to get rid of fleas and other insects is to use pennyroyal oil. Spray the oil over the animal to be cleaned and over any place where insects are bothersome.

Round and rump steaks are economical because they have but one bone in them. They can be made tender by marinating, but after steaks are marinated they must be cooked on a very hot broiler or they will lose their juice.

Beef hearts roasted make a savory low-priced meat dish. Select two or three small rather than one big heart. Have the butcher trim close, removing the ventricles and linings.

Almond Wafers. Mix thoroughly equal quantities of dry flour and sifted sugar; with every four tablespoons of this mixture that it is intended to use work in two beaten eggs two and one-half ounces of chopped almonds or pistachio nuts, a small quantity of fresh yeast and as much cream as will make a thick batter. Let the mixture settle and bake the wafers in the usual way.
