GATHERED IN THE WASHINGTON SHOPS

Packages of two dozen sheets of waxed paper, just the thing for lining bake pans or to use for wrapping the luncheon cake and sandwiches, are sold as low as 2 cents each.

Add White Sugar. Any one who is troubled in getting black lead to stay on the stove should add a little white sugar to the paste before putting it on the stove, then proceed as usual. A few drops of vinegar will also help.

BABY'S CARRIAGE PILLOW.

Linen, lawn, nainsook, batiste, or cambric may be used in making this pillow case. As the face of the baby rests on the back of the pillow when in use it is only necessary to have the side smooth. Close as the pattern looks in our small illustration, it is really quite open. It is nearly twenty inches across, and the extreme width of the border is five inches.

NEW COMBINATIONS.



The coat is made of printing eponge, showing pink and black flowers with foliage, on a gray ground. Black velvet bands are used as a trimming, combined with jet buttons and loops of silver cord. The outline of the coat is square across the back with slashes at each side. The sleeves are set in at a normal armhole.

Worn with this is a skirt of white serge, which fits smoothly around the hips and is draped high on one side, showing a pleated underdrift of white silk. A black velvet cord ornament is placed at the end of the drapery folds.

Salt or Caraway Sticks. When making fill rolls use part of the dough, as follows: Roll a small portion of dough between hands and board to form a long roll, tapering at both ends, about three inches long; score top slightly with knife, brush with melted butter, sprinkle a little salt and caraway seed over and bake in very brisk oven as soon as light. Keep well apart in pan.

Fig Pudding. One cup chopped figs, one cup milk, one cup molasses, 1-1/2 cups graham flour, 1-1/2 teaspoons soda moistened with hot water. Steam three hours.
