THE WAR DAY BY DAY Fifty Years Ago.

March 24, 1864—Orders Were Issued by Gen. George G. Meade Reorganizing the Army of the Potomac Into Three Corps of Approximately 30,000 Men Each—Gen. Grant Takes the Field.

Fifty years ago today an order was issued by George G. Meade, who was organizing the Army of the Potomac into three corps of approximately 30,000 men each. The issuance of this important order synchronized with the arrival at army headquarters of Lieut. Gen. U. S. Grant, the new commander of all the Federal forces, who took the field that morning, coming by train from Washington to Brandy Station, Va.

The Sixth Corps was commanded by Gen. John Sedgwick—"Uncle John"—sterling and steadfast soldier, rugged, brave as a lion and of a peculiarly gentle and winning personality. He had long commanded the men of this corps. He had borne the brunt of unsuccessful fighting at Fredericksburg and Salem Church, when co-operating with Hooker in the unfortunate movements of the Chancellorsville campaign.

The cavalry corps of the army, numbering about 15,000 men, was to have a new commander in the person of Gen. Philip H. Sheridan, who, like Grant, had been summoned from the West, and who was unknown to the men of the Army of the Potomac. Sheridan had won distinction as an infantry officer by leading his division of infantry up the steel side of Missionary Ridge in the battle of Chattanooga November 25, 1862.

The appointment of Sheridan displaced Gen. Alfred Pleasonton, who for a year had been in command of the cavalry. This was no reflection upon the manner in which Pleasonton had performed his duties, for he was an efficient, if not a brilliant cavalry commander.

The reorganization of the army, however, was not ordered for the purpose of disciplining discontented officers, but entirely in an effort on the part of Gen. Meade to secure the best possible organization for the coming campaign against Lee.

It would have been well had this corps been consolidated with the Army of the Potomac at the time of the reorganization, but this was not done out of deference to the supposed feeling of Gen. Burnside on the subject, as he ranked first in the list of the army's commanders. The arrangement of keeping this corps an independent command would not work satisfactorily. When, on May 24, in the field, it was consolidated with the Army of the Potomac, Gen. Burnside accepted the situation without a murmur.

Under the new arrangement the First Army Corps, which under Gen. John F. Reynolds opened the battle of Gettysburg (his leader falling at its head), and the Third Army Corps, which under Gen. Daniel Sickles had been shattered in the second day of the great battle, lost their individual identity. The First Corps had been under the recent command of Gen. John Newton, and the Third Corps under Gen. David B. Barney, both of whom had commanded divisions in their respective corps at the battle of Gettysburg.

In addition to the great force now being put into shape for the campaign against Lee, Grant had ordered the assembling of an army of about 40,000 men at Fortress Monroe, under Maj. Gen. E. F. Butler. This force was to co-operate with the Army of the Potomac by moving up the James River as the main army started across country toward Richmond. Other forces were being gathered in West Virginia, to operate there and in the Valley of the Shenandoah, under Gen. Franz Sigel.
