


ENGLISH REALIZE DANGER FROM GERMANS AS LATTER TAKE VITAL COAST POSITIONS

England had most to fear when the Germans pushed their way to the channel coast of Belgium after the capture of Antwerp. From public mass meetings in Great Britain it was evident that the people there felt the war was becoming more and more a fight to the death between the German and the English.

Gen. French, in the field with the allies as head of the English forces, bent an urgent plea for more officers to fill his depleted ranks. Meanwhile the allies and Germans fought hard in Northwestern France and along the Belgian border.

GLASS OPPOSES COTTON SCHEMES

Henry Wants Money for the Planters' Benefit Raised by Valorization of Coffee.

WOULD TAX EVERYBODY

Virginian Says This Can Wreck the Financial Fabric of the United States.

Representative Carter Glass, of Virginia, chairman of the Committee on Banking and Currency, was enthusiastically applauded yesterday, when, in the course of a speech, he excoriated Southern members who have proposed either the insurance of coffee and far currency for the relief of cotton planters and dealers in the South who find themselves in distress as a result of the war in Europe.
