GENERAL POP IN FOODSTUFFS

Retail Meat Prices, Especially, Show Smart Declines This Week.

VEGETABLES ARE LOWER

Some Dealers Believe Low Prices Will Last a Few Weeks Longer Before Advancing.

Yesterday, other grades are about the same as last week's quotations. The more popular items of poultry are higher this week than a week ago, having advanced 1 cent. Broilers are listed the same as last Thursday, 15 cents. Ducks have gone up 2 cents, selling at 30 cents a pound. Turkey prices are 25 cents, 1 cent lower, and last week at \$1.25 to \$1.50 a pair, have dropped to \$1 and \$1.25.

Market generally declined to forecast the price, declaring that the future might see a greater influx of market produce or that the present unusually large supply would be cut down. Some have believed the prices would go lower for a week or two, and then would begin to advance.


