BIG NET GAINS IN WAR ISSUES

Mexican Situation Causes Careful Trading in Several Industrials.

COAL RULING UNKNOWN

Anthrax Decision May Have Its Effect Today—Allis-Chalmers Heads Active Specialties.

New York, Aug. 12.—Apprehension regarding the Mexican situation caused the stock market to present a checked appearance today, the standard rails and industrials exhibiting a cautious tendency while specialties, together with war stocks, displayed renewed life. Standard issues closed with fractional losses for the session, while the coal and war stocks showed substantial net gains. Crucible Steel failed to share the strength of the other war issues.

Although the standard issues were heavy at the close and around the lowest prices for the day there was not the slightest indication in the market that the Street had any knowledge of the decision in the anthrax case. This unfavorable decision has been expected and many commission houses have steadily kept advising their customers to refrain from making long commitments in the coal stocks. This has been reflected in the comparative quiet of these issues during the session, however, it is expected to have an unfavorable effect at the opening of tomorrow's session.

LOCAL CHANGE INACTIVE

Twenty-five Shares of Graphophone Being Bought.

With most of its members out of the city, the Washington Stock Exchange continues inactive. The securities are comparatively firm, but there is virtually no trading, offers and bidders being unable to come together. W. B. Hibbs presided at yesterday's session with Henry Burt as his fellow broker in making quotations.

Bubonic Death in California. Sacramento, Cal., Aug. 12.—Nick Gloria, who died at Martinez on July 12, died from bubonic plague. The California board of health was informed today that a bacteriological examination showed that Gloria's death is the first caused by bubonic plague in California since October, 1912.


