El Paso, Feb. 27.—Ideal weather and track conditions prevailed at Juarez this afternoon. The spectators found the task of picking the winners a most difficult one, and but one favorite scored for the form players.

Moneymaker annexed the feature. Bonanza set a stiff pace throughout and hung on gamely, but Moneymaker, coming from the rear, in the final eighth closed with a cyclonic rush and grabbed the lead right at the wire.

New York, Feb. 27.—"Bill" Bingham, the most popular man in Harvard University and captain of the track team, works his way through college. This cheering bit of information was just leaked out, but Bingham has never made a secret of it.

Seven years ago Bingham was working in a cloth mill at Lawrence, Mass. He was earning a mere pittance, and was then 20 years of age. But he was ambitious, and his friends learning of his desire to obtain an education, raised a fund for him, something slightly over \$25, and "Bill" matriculated at Exeter. He waited table to pay part of his expenses the first year. A scholarship later solved the problem of remaining in school.

Bingham is still self-supporting, but finds time outside of his studies and work to keep up his training.
