Delegation at Party Convention Cannot Ballot on Its Issues.

A large number of Washington women will start for Chicago on June 3 to attend the Woman's party convention on June 3 and 4. Mrs. John F. Ryan has secured the Pullman reservations for most of the party, and they will travel as one delegation.

Among those who will leave next Saturday are Mrs. Harold Walker, Miss Gladys Hinckley, Mrs. George Rublee, Mrs. Herman Gauch, Mrs. William Kent, Mrs. John Kerfoot, Mrs. John Wald, Mrs. Connelly, Mrs. Grace Odell, Mrs. Gilson Gardner, Mrs. George Neudham, Miss Edith Goodie, Miss Aline Solomon, Miss Sheldon Jackson, Mrs. Helena Weed Hill, Mrs. Nina Allender, Mrs. W. T. Burch, Miss M. E. Dabney, Miss Lucy Burns and Mrs. Charles Edward Russell.

The District women cheerfully admit they will have no votes in the convention, but they will have a voice in all the discussions of the three-day session.

"The women voters of the country are the only women who exercise direct influence at this time upon its political destiny," said Miss Lucy Burns, national vice chairman of the Congressional Union.

"They will decide in Chicago what policy they will pursue in the next Presidential election. It is the first time in the history of this country that women have formed a national political party. Their party will run no candidates and seek no offices. And it will have but one plank—the passage of the amendment to the Constitution of the United States enfranchising women."

Every woman voter who sits in this convention is pledged to vote upon that issue, and to withhold her support from any one of the political parties which does not support women's suffrage.

The business meetings will be held in the Blackstone Theater. The first spectacular event will be staged in Lincoln Park, when the hundreds of women assembled will gather to see the statue of Lincoln, and there dedicate themselves and the Woman's party. In a solemn ceremony, to the enfranchisement of the other half of the people of the United States.

"On Tuesday the Battery 'A' boys were called out, and left for the border, and I sure had to see them go down in that terrible country. We lost three from the house here, including Mrs. Johnson's 15-year-old son, and that littleascal did not enroll until the last minute, and it surely surprised us all. But just to give you an instance of how the people here are raving to get at those greasers. The battery, when the call was made Tuesday noon, only had ninety men and when they left Thursday morning they had recruited to within six of the fighting strength of the battery which requires 170 men."

"It would have done you good to see the send off of this little town gave the boys; but it was very sad, too. Nearly all of the officers and stores closed and the cadets in dress uniform from the New Mexico Military Institute marched down in a body with their band and gave a concert on the station lawn. I never in all my life saw such a display of patriotism. When the train pulled out they could almost have heard a pin drop, and I guess many a little mother, wife and sweetheart went home and cried herself to sleep that night."

"My son to whom I refer is Mr. Ralph H. Stansell, well known in this city, having been for years in charge

of the office of the Seaboard Air Line Railway here. He is now in very poor health and was obliged to go to New Mexico, where I am glad to say he has very much improved.
