Committee Will Propose Seven Capital War Vessels

The subcommittee of the Senate Naval Committee decided yesterday to recommend to the full committee the immediate construction of four battle cruisers and three battleships of the highest power.

The construction of all authorized vessels would begin at once.

The committee also adopted the five-year building program of the General Board of the navy, with practically no modification. It added the sum of \$5,000,000 to the amount appropriated by the House for reserve ammunition for the navy.

Three battleships, four battle cruisers, four scout cruisers, ten torpedo boat destroyers, three fleet submarines of 800 tons each, twenty-seven submarines to cost \$700,000 each...

four scout cruisers, ten torpedo boat destroyers, three fleet submarines of 800 tons each, twenty-seven submarines to cost \$700,000 each; one fuel ship, one hospital ship, one ammunition ship.

The recommendation of the General Board includes provisions for aircraft service and reserve ammunition.

With respect to the ten first-class battleships, the amendment provides they shall carry as heavy armor and as powerful armament as any vessels of their class...

MACHINE GUNS LACKING

Three Hundred and Eighty Needed to Put Militia on War Footing.

From official sources it was disclosed yesterday that the National Guard lacks 380 machine guns.

The total number of that organization of more than 120,000 men is only 54 guns.

This disclosure reveals a situation that must be remedied at once, it was stated. If the National Guard becomes a part of the Federal army it must be equipped on a parity with the regulars.

DISTRICT GUARD MOVE DELAYED

Preparations for Border Cannot Be Completed Under Ten Days, Is Belief.
