MULE GIVES IMPROMPTU 'HARE AND HOUNDS' RUN

Outruns His Pursuers in Wild Chase Across City.

A wild-eyed unidentified mule led about fifteen "drivers," a half dozen motorcycles and a dozen or more bicycles one glorious chase through the streets of the city and out through Rock Creek Park Saturday evening.

The stray animal was first sighted at Eleventh and M streets northwest by "Jack" Hines. Mr. Mule resisted being taken into custody and started down M street on the gallop.

Here the mule, who was without halter or bridle, left the highway and took to the open. Some of the more daring of the motorcycle riders followed the runaway on his new course over the hills and across the bottoms, but in spite of their efforts the truant could not be placed in captivity and the chase was abandoned.

HIGH COST OF "SPUDS" DROPPING TO NORMAL

Decline Is Rapid as the Strike Crisis Is Over.
