Wife Asks Absolute Divorce. Charging desertion and misconduct, Mrs. Emma Mullican filed suit for absolute divorce yesterday against Harvey Mullican. The couple were married May 2, 1918. Mrs. Mullican states her husband deserted her on May 20, the same year.

Three Months for Knife Wielder. Lawrence W. Dennis, colored, was sentenced today to serve three months in jail and fined \$10 for assaulting Policeman Leo Taylor, of the Third precinct.

Grand Jury Indictments. Hart G. Brown, 22 years of age, who on December 15 last shot Mrs. Mary Ferrell, 26 years of age, in a jealous fit, was indicted yesterday by the grand jury for assault with a dangerous weapon and for assault with intent to kill.

Four Years for Robbery. Bertha Manley, a 19-year-old colored girl, was sentenced to four years in the penitentiary yesterday by Justice Siddons in Criminal Court No. 1, for enticing a white man into a house on Maryland avenue southwest and robbing him of \$20. The robbery occurred December 16 last.

Wife Sues for Maintenance. Charging her husband with refusing to support her, Mrs. Florence R. Lewis filed a suit for maintenance yesterday against Charles R. Lewis, a navy aviator. The couple were married last November. Shortly afterward, the wife states, her husband attempted to secure an absolute divorce, from her in Maryland, but failed. Her attorney is Henry F. Woodward.
