

Mrs. Helen H. Gardener's Name, Literary in Origin, Goes to Senate For Civil Service Commissioner

How the daughter of an old-fashioned Virginia clergyman took a new name when she feared her liberal views would clash with his orthodox precepts, and how this name later was legalized, eclipsing the memory of her patronymic and replacing that of her marriage, was recalled yesterday when President Wilson sent the nomination of Mrs. Helen Hamilton Gardener, a member of the Civil Service Commission, to the Senate.

Medical student, writer, sociologist and suffragist, Mrs. Gardener is the first woman ever to be named for such a post. Another precedent is the sending for confirmation of a non-de jure Christian home in America.
