FARMERS SEEK TO ISSUE NEW GERMAN TRADE SAVINGS PAPER

Outlet for Surplus Is to Be Urged at Meeting in Indianapolis.

Extension of credit to Germany and associated European countries for the purchase of surplus supplies of food and raw materials in the United States will be strongly advocated by organized agriculture at the American Farm Bureau Federation in Indianapolis next week. It was announced by the federation here yesterday.

"We must open up our usual and natural outlets for cotton, wool, grain and meats, if we are to relieve the present disastrous economic situation which has already cut the farmer's income and below cost of production and is rapidly reacting to close shops and factories and throw millions out of employment," said Gray Silver, Washington representative of the federation.

"There is no real surplus crop production in this country. With the exception of corn, potatoes and apples the total production of most of the important farm crops is under the five-year average. Domestic and European demands have taken a decided slump, but one of our big troubles is that some of our normal outlets are closed. Of the 9,000,000 bales of cotton normally exported before the war, 3,000,000 went to Germany.

"The large accumulation of coarse wool stocks appears to be a direct result of the inability of the Central European powers to buy their former quota."

Two new Treasury savings securities will be issued during the coming year, a \$1 Treasury savings stamp and a \$25 Treasury savings certificate, it was announced yesterday. The \$1 stamp will be non-interest bearing, will be bright red in color on a green background and will bear the portrait of Alexander Hamilton, first Secretary of the Treasury. The \$25 certificate will be similar in design to the \$100 and \$1000 Treasury savings certificates.

The new securities will supply a \$1 unit for saving and a registered government security in the \$25 denomination, which can be purchased conveniently through the accumulation of \$1 Treasury savings stamps.

Notwithstanding the tendency during the past year to invest funds in Liberty bonds and Victory notes, Treasury officials declare that the demand for the savings securities has continued strong all over the country. They are especially attractive to investors because exempt from normal income and State taxes.

The American Federation of Labor and many fraternal and social organizations have expressed themselves in favor of liberal issues of government securities in order to provide safe and convenient investments for wage earners.

2 U. S. WOMEN HELD BY LITHUANIANS

Greece Accepts League Provisions on Labor

The government of Greece officially has notified the secretary general of the league of nations of the ratification of the draft convention adopted by the international Labor Conference held in Washington, November, 1919, and according to a cable received by Ernest Greenwood, American correspondent of the international Labor office.

The legislation adopted by this ratification contains some of the most progressive labor and welfare laws of any in the world. The draft convention concerning unemployment requires the member ratifying it to establish a system of free public employment agencies under the control of a central authority. It also provides for the operation of a national system which will be a co-ordination of both public and private free agencies. This will gradually eliminate all private fee-charging agencies.

Two conventions have to do specifically with the welfare of women in industry. One of them provides that no woman should be permitted to work during the six weeks following child-birth and shall have the right to leave her work six weeks before the probable time of delivery. It also provides that while she is absent from her work in accordance with these terms she shall be paid benefits sufficient for the full and healthy maintenance of herself and her child.

LONDON, Nov. 29.—The clergy are taking the little god Cupid in hand and endeavoring to guide his darts the way they should go. Most prominent in this field of activity is the Rev. James Dixon, Vicar of Willesden, who is a great matchmaker. He organizes dances and weakly entertainments in the vicarage garden during the summer, and holds parties during the winter.

"The boys and girls meet here," he said. "They become attached and ultimately fall in love, and then they get the best for themselves. You see, the church is quite near by and handy."

When Dixon first started these entertainments he was strongly criticized, but he pursued the even tenor of his way, relying on his popularity and now the young folk of Willesden would rather be "round at the vicarage" than any place else.
