BURSTING METEOR GIVEN AS CAUSE OF EARTH'S TREMORS

U. of Va. Astronomers Connect It With Recent Comet.

CHARLOTTESVILLE, Va., Aug. 14.—Authorities at the McCormick Observatory at the University of Virginia believe the severe earth tremors felt over the counties of Albemarle, Buckingham, Nelson, Fluvanna and Cumberland early last Sunday morning, were caused by a great meteorite, traveling north to south, bursting near Howardsville, this county.

Here and in Scottsville and Howardsville the vibrations were so violent that it was thought by many to be an earthquake.
