SALE OF ALTERNATE SECTIONS IN MISSOURI.

By the President of the United States. Pursuance of law, I, Franklin Pierce, President of the United States of America, do hereby declare and make known that public sales of the sections and parts of sections, being all those bearing odd numbers, which remain in the United States within six miles on each side of the Southwest Pacific Railroad, in the State of Missouri, subject to sale at two dollars and fifty cents per acre, as provided by the act of 10th June, 1852, entitled "An act granting the right of way to the State of Missouri, and a portion of the public lands, to aid in the construction of certain railroads in said State," and especially excepted from graduation at the price by the act of 10th June, 1852, will be held at the undermentioned land offices in said State at the periods hereinafter designated, to wit:
