AN IMPORTANT RULING. The District Commissioners Must Act as an Entirety. THE ACTION OF TWO NOT VALID, ACCORDING TO A DECISION OF THE JUDGE.

Yesterday, Judge James, in the Equity Court, heard the case of Mary Ellen Bush et al. against John H. Green and the District of Columbia. The petitioner sought to enjoin the defendant, Green, from erecting and maintaining a live stock yard in square 210, west of the Riggs Market on F Street between 14th and 15th streets northwest.

Mr. A. R. Worthington appeared for Mr. Green and Mr. S. T. Thomas for the District and claimed that under this amendment the inspector of buildings had the power to issue a writ of injunction to prevent the erection of a building, but Judge Miller said that the more reason the husband has for using a pistol the more necessary it was to put him under bonds.
