MOWED DOWN BY MACHINE GUNS. Two Thousand Killed Before the Others Yielded. SUICIDE OF COMMANDERS. LONDON, Nov. 9.—A dispatch from Johannesburg to the Pall Mall Gazette says that the Fort Tull column, consisting of 300 Bechuanaland police and a number of Chief Khama's men, under command of Commander Raaf, captured Bulwago on November 4, the day after the column had repulsed an attack made upon it by the Matabeles, under command of Lobengula, Lobengula's son-in-law, during which Lobengula is reported to have been killed. The Matabeles fought with desperate fury, but they found it impossible to stand up against the machine guns, which laid the dead in swaths upon the field.
