LOCAL HAPPENINGS OF INTEREST TO WEST END RESIDENTS.

On March 24 representatives of the miners employed in the fields near the upper end of the Chesapeake and Ohio canal and the presidents of the various coal companies interested there will confer in regard to the proposed reduction in mining rates.

This amount they have gotten from 1883 up to the present time, with the exception of the interval from 1884 to 1887, when the price was necessarily cut down owing to the decrease in the selling price of the fuel.

A strike was participated in by the miners, though, before the reduced figure was accepted. No such action is anticipated, however, in connection with the reduction now proposed. The miners have reasonable men considering their cause. The general belief is that the proposed reduction will be accepted by the miners.
