CHEAP HOMES FOR THE POOR An interesting report was submitted to the board of managers of the Citizens' Relief Association at a meeting held last Saturday.

Marked Improvement. "There has been a marked improvement in the methods of relief work and in the condition of the needy during the last few years," says the committee.
