PROPERTY LOST \$10,000,000. NEW YORK, July 2.—Divers and wreckers are still hard at work on the burned North German Lloyd steamers. It is believed there are yet many bodies to be recovered from the Saale, and two large wrecking derricks are alongside her, removing the bent and twisted pieces of heavy iron that cover her hold.

A dispatch from New York last night says: It is believed that 200 lives were lost and 300 persons were injured in a great fire at the pier of the North German Lloyd Steamship Company at Hoboken, N. J., which broke out at 4 p. m. Saturday and was still burning throughout Sunday night. The fire started among cotton bales from an unknown cause. In less than fifteen minutes it covered an area a quarter of a mile long, extending outward from the actual shore line to the bulkheads, from 600 to 700 feet away from the pier, and over ocean liners and a dozen or more smaller harbor craft in its grasp.

Counting the Missing. The North German Lloyd company took the crew lists of its steamers, checked off those members who are in hospitals or reported safe and believes the others to be lost. The missing, as previously stated, number about 200.

Many Were on the Bremen. One of the officers of the Bremen says there were fully 200 persons on board that vessel when the fire broke out. The master of the vessel, however, says that the majority of them being women. A boat was lowered from the Bremen shortly after the alarm had been given, but the craft capsized and all on board were precipitated into the water. None of them were saved by those remaining on the vessel.
