Native Hawaiians Demonstrate Unfitness to Legislate.

HAVE FORMED PARTY ON RACE LINES

Violent Antagonism to Governor Dole.

DELEGATION COMING HERE

Special Correspondence of The Evening Star. HONOLULU, May 4, 1901. The first legislature of the territory of Hawaii closed its allotted session of sixty days on the 30th of April. It had accomplished but little of the important business before it.

The Governor's Reply. The governor's reply to the first of those applications, a positive refusal in which he persisted, was in terms which are perhaps unique in gubernatorial action, as follows: "The law provided for a special session of the legislature in case there is an adjournment of a regular session without the enactment of the necessary appropriations for the conduct of the government during the adjournment of both time and money, and therefore has the power to compel the calling of a special session for this purpose."

Incapacity of the Legislature. If no governor in the Union has hitherto so repelled to a legislature, probably no legislature has given such cause for it. The most conspicuous example of the members' utter incapacity to do business was in the fact that it took over one-half of the sixty working days of the session to pass the first bill, which was to appropriate the sum of \$40,000 for legislative expenses.

The Race Line Drawn. This native "independent home rule" party distinctly draws the race line. It was its intention to exclude the whites from political power, absorbing such power into the possession of the natives, including part-whites, a thing never undertaken before.

Use of the Hawaiian Tongue. A serious departure in the conduct of the legislature from the manifest intention of Congress, whether sufficient or not to invalidate the proceedings, was the constant and prevailing use of the Hawaiian tongue by the native members.
