Forecast till 8 p.m. Sunday—For the Dis-

trict of Columbia, Delaware, Maryland and

Virginia, rain tonight; clearing Sunday; in-

creasing northwesterly, shifting to north-

westerly winds.

Weather conditions and general forecast—

A well-defined depression developed

within the extensive area of low barometric

pressure that has occupied the southern

states during the last few days. There

was evidence of this development about

Georgia and South Carolina Friday morn-

ing, and this morning the disturbance is

centered off the North Carolina coast, with

barometer readings below 29.80. The in-

dications are that this storm will move

northward off the coast, attended by

increasing and high northeasterly, shifting

to northerly and northwesterly winds and

rain from North Carolina to New England.

It also indicates that the storm will

visory warnings have been sent to
