To Command Gulf Department.

Col. Stanton Retired.

Stanton served as a private in the 43d Ohio Infantry from September, 1861, until March, 1863, and in September, 1867, he was appointed second lieutenant, 23d Regular Artillery. In February, 1871, while holding the rank of first lieutenant, he was transferred to the 6th Cavalry and was assigned to the 1st Squadron to the time of his retirement as colonel of the 6th Cavalry on the 7th instant.
