ABE HUMMEL GOES TO JAIL

ENTERS BLACKWELL'S ISLAND PRISON BY THE BACK DOOR.

Had His Head Shaved and Mustache Cut Off Before He Gave Himself Up.

NEW YORK, May 21.—Abe Hummel, convicted of conspiracy in the Dodge-Morse case and sentenced to a year in prison, got into the Blackwell's Island penitentiary through the back door yesterday.

With the nephew, Abe Kaffenberg, the same who directed some of the maneuvers in the Dodge-Morse case, Hummel left his house shortly before 11 o'clock this morning.

At about 3:40 o'clock a big man and a little man came walking north on 7th street behind the penitentiary.

Once inside the gray walls of the prison there were only the prison officials and warden Hummel and his nephew.

As he stood waiting for the order to strip one, not even his closest friends, who have recognized, save for his diminutive stature, the dapper "first night" of the Broadway theaters.
