WEATHER FORECAST.

Rain Tonight, Tomorrow Fair, Colder, Increasing Winds.

Forecast 7th 8 P.M. Thursday.—For the District of Columbia, rain ton. Thursday, fair, colder; winds becoming northwesterly and increasing.

For Virginia, rain tonight, colder in northern and western portions. Thursday, fair, colder; fresh southerly winds, shifting to northwesterly and increasing.

Weather Conditions and General Forecast.—The weather over the Middle West Tuesday morning has moved over the extreme north with great rapidity, leaving a trough to the southwestward into the upper Mississippi valley.

It will be much colder in the Ohio valley, the lower lake region, and also colder in the west to the middle Atlantic states. In the Gulf states the weather will be partly cloudy without marked temperature changes.

Storm warnings are displayed on the Great Lakes, except Superior, on the New Jersey coast and at New York. The winds along the middle Atlantic coast will be west to northwest and increasing; on the south Atlantic coast fresh and mostly south to southwest; on the Gulf coast light to fresh southerly, and on the lower lakes high west to northwest.
