**Widow Brings Suit Against Ticket Broker for Alleged Breach of Promise.**

Seventy-five plasters in the shape of \$1,000 bills are needed to repair the injury to her heart, declares Mrs. Sadie B. Van Horne, a widow with two children, in a suit which she has filed in the District Superior Court to recover damages for alleged breach of promise from Frederick H.
