

MIX-UP FOR TAFT

Fond Du Lac Threatened Close Gates Against Him.

BUT VISIT WILL BE PAID

City Did Not Want President's Time There Cut Down.

WIRES HOT WITH MESSAGES

Fear Felt That With Municipality Dissatisfied Adequate Police Protection Would Be Lacking.

SALEM, Ore., October 12.—The Fond du Lac incident, the most interesting connected with the recent travels of a President, was officially declared closed for some hours here today on the way to Sacramento and San Francisco. And President Taft is looking forward to his visit to Fond du Lac, in the insurgent state of Wisconsin, with an interest greater than felt in any other city on his 13,000-mile itinerary.

Opinions at Variance.

The mayor of Fond du Lac announced that if Fond du Lac could not have Mr. Taft for two hours and a half it didn't want him at all. This decision apparently was not made until after the President had telegraphed to Fond du Lac, even if it is only for a few minutes.

LONG FLIGHT IN TRIAL

OVER CHESAPEAKE BAY

Navy Aviators Leave Annapolis and Land at Smiths Point, 63 Miles Distant.

Message From Mayor.

It begins with the following telegram sent by Mayor Frank J. Wolf of Fond du Lac to Secretary Hilles, on the presidential train at Cheyenne: "We have made elaborate arrangements for the President's visit to Fond du Lac. We are advised that our time is to be divided with other reception committees in the Fox River valley. We would like to know definitely the time allotted to Fond du Lac, and whether you would be able to carry out the program and arrangements."

Views of Postmaster.

As soon as this action of the mayor and the committee was made public Postmaster George Watson of Fond du Lac wired to Mr. Hilles as follows: "Kindly give the people of Fond du Lac an opportunity to express their loyalty to the President and his passengers."

Everything Is Settled.

Yesterday came the following, signed by the mayor of Fond du Lac and the chairman of all the committees: "The mayor and citizens of Fond du Lac are anxious to entertain the President and his party October 20. The misunderstanding as to time assigned to Fond du Lac has been cleared up in a meeting held at Fond du Lac by the President's representative."
