AMATEUR LEAGUE RACES REACHING CRUCIAL STAGE

The crucial stage is being reached in practically every race in the amateur leagues. There hardly a circuit in which the next two weeks will not give a fairly definite view as to how matters stand with respect to the probable pennant winners.

In some of the leagues these two or three leading teams may carry the race right down to the end of the season and tuck, but it is likely that there will be only one or two such close competitors.

Perhaps there is no league which gives promise of a closer race than the Capital City. In that the fight is between two teams, but there is not a great deal of advantage for either.

The league in which the teams in general seem to be most evenly matched is the Central. Four clubs have been in the running for the championship in that circuit for a month, with none having a great advantage over the others.

One series in the Federal League has been completed, the circuit organized in the Washington, D. C. circuit, and the championship in the first series, at that point as it will probably be the winner of the one now being carried on for the final claim to the title.
