labor troubles was expected when the special session of the legislature resumed its sessions today. It is thought early action will be had on five measures, one of which provides for compulsory arbitration of labor disputes, introduced yesterday in both branches of the legislature and referred to committees.

Reports from the various army commanders in the field in Colorado, located at Louisa, Trinidad and Canon City, were summarized by the War Department today as follows: "At Louisa the proclamation with respect to delivering up arms and ammunition was posted yesterday afternoon. There is no report as yet as to the result. The conditions are quiet in this district at the present time. It is also reported that conditions are quiet at Trinidad. The proclamation has not been spread through this region as yet, because until yesterday there were not sufficient troops there to provide the necessary machinery for making the proclamation effective. At Canon City the proclamation has been posted, and the work of taking in arms began yesterday and will be continued through the 6th and 7th instants. Not many arms were turned in yesterday."
