Cost of Blue Cross Work.

The Italian government has asked President Hawkesley of the English Society for the Protection of Animals whether he would be willing to organize a Blue Cross Society in this country in case of war.

Mr. Hawkesley estimated that the cost of a complete hospital, including horse ambulances, food for animals, surgical instruments and supplies, would be 75,000 francs (\$15,000). It is understood that if Italy enters the conflict the British Blue Cross stands ready to provide a completely equipped hospital; contributions are started here.
