

LONDON BEING DRILLED AGAINST AERIAL RAID

Householders Being Instructed What to Do Should Zeppelins Bombard Metropolis.

LONDON, July 5.—"Zeppelin drill" has now taken its place alongside the familiar fire drill in some London factories and business places.

For households, advertisers are furnishing neat placards with instructions for conduct in case of air raids.

"Don't go into the street. Close all windows and doors on lower floors. Keep buckets of water and sand up stairs. Have respirators handy in bedrooms."

Water in Bath tub. A housewife writes to a newspaper to describe the steps she has taken to protect her household.

"Every night the bathtub upstairs is left half full of water. On every landing are buckets of water and sand. In every room there is a bowl of water ready for mistaking the respirators, and all my family have been advised to keep their respirators under the pillow so as to be within easy reach."

A schoolmistress writes advising parents to instruct their small children to the use of the respirator.

"It would startle a child considerably," she notes, "to be awakened in the middle of the night and have a respirator clapped over its mouth."

Authorities Not Agreed. There is no unanimity of opinion even among the police authorities as to the proper mode of procedure for householders in case of Zeppelin attack.

In most places the police have advised parents to instruct their small children to go into their cellars, but the chief of police at Windsor is sure this is inadvisable.

His code of directions, which reads with a matter-of-fact common sense almost Yankee in its directness, is as follows:

"Do not congregate in one room or in the basement, as has been freely recommended. Some of the bombs recently used crashed through roof and fell to basement and then exploded. Again, if gas bombs are used, the cellar with doors and windows closed is not a haven of safety."

"In a few words: In the event of an air raid put your trust in Providence, have something efficacious on the premises for coping with a fire in its earlier stages; clench your teeth and do your best."

WINDAU, ON THE BALTIC, RUSSIA'S ATLANTIC CITY

Watering Place, Recently Subjected to Attack, Lacks All Modern Conveniences.

Windau, whence an attack of a German squadron was reported as being repulsed the other day, forms the subject of the latest war primer of the National Geographic Society.

Windau is Russia's Atlantic City, the place where the Russian family of moderate income goes to spend the vacation period.

Before the outbreak of the war it had succeeded in winning quite a reputation as a bathing resort, and in increasing numbers of summer-wearied business men from Petrograd found their way each year to its strand.

Besides its profits from seasonal visitors, Windau also enjoyed a considerable commerce with other ports upon the Baltic.

Few Inhabitants Russian. Riga, the first commercial harbor of the Baltic provinces, lies 110 miles away, west-southwest.

Libau, the Russian naval station now held by the German invaders, lies about twenty miles to the south, and is a point about midway between Windau and Memel.

Windau is connected with Riga and Memel by rail. It is situated on the River Windau, which flows into the sea.

It has a population of 10,000, few of whom are Russians. The harbor of Windau is a convenient one for Russian blockade runners.

It is free from ice almost all the year around, and the peak of winter trade has reached some importance. The annual imports of Windau have totaled as high as \$4,000,000, while it has exported wares in amounts varying between \$4,000,000 and \$12,000,000 a year.

Grains, timber and other agricultural produce have made up the bulk of its exports, and its imports have been largely manufactured goods.

No Modern Conveniences. Windau is an old Lettish town. Its appearance testifies to its age, which is underscored for the visitor by its entire lack of those modern conveniences that make present-day life worth living.

And Riga, just 100 miles away, is probably the most modern city in all the East. Most interesting of its relics is the old castle of Windau, built in 1290.

BRICKS RECEIVED DAILY. Occoquan Plants Sending Material for Two New High Schools.

Brick for the new Central High and M Street High school buildings being erected by the District and stone for public roadway use are being received here in quantities from the Occoquan workhouse industrial plants, the tug Louise arriving almost daily with brick and stone laden lighters in tow.

The brick is all brought to the storage yard at the foot of 19th street southwest, and the stone comes to the District sand yard at the foot of 9th street south or to the pumping station over on the Eastern branch.

The receipts of bricks are about \$5,000 daily and from now on about as fast as they are received they will be sent up to the sites of the new high schools.
