NO RIGHT OF ASYLUM PREVAILS IN HAITI. Such Diplomatic Immunities Are Obtained by Treaties; International Law Silent.

FRENCH LEGATION NOT EXEMPTED FROM SEARCH. Seizure of President Guillaume Legal Under Rulings of U. S. State Department.

Current events in Haiti, particularly the dragging of President Guillaume from the French legation at the capital, Port au Prince, and his assassination yesterday morning after he had obtained refuge in that diplomatic building, serve to draw attention to the customs of nations as to what frequently has been mislabeled "the right of political asylum."

No such right exists, in fact or in law, so far as Haiti is concerned, although some countries have treaties which provide for such rights.

TEUTON ARMY CONTRACTS PLACED WITH ARTISANS. System of Awards Has Brought Complaints to Be Filed From Several Sources.

Consuls may harbor political refugees, but as the law of nations confers upon them no right to do this, and the treaty between the United States and Haiti is silent upon the subject, no sufficient cause of complaint would arise if refugees so harbored were to be taken by the local authorities from the consular abode.

Mr. Hollister, who was minister of the United States at Port au Prince in 1868, wrote a dispatch May 8, 1868, to the State Department here, which was the basis for some time of negotiations which had for their object either the establishment of a right of asylum for political refugees in diplomatic and consular buildings or the refusal by various governments which had diplomatic offices in Haiti at that time to recognize any such right.
